

Professor Sameh Kamel Morcos FRCS, DMRD, FFRRCSI, FRCR was born in Alexandria, Egypt. He did his undergraduate medical education at Cairo University and qualified in June 1971.

He is a Consultant Radiologist at Sheffield Teaching Hospitals NHS Foundation Trust, Sheffield, UK since 1983. He was awarded a personal chair in Diagnostic Imaging by the University of Sheffield in 2005.

Professor Morcos is the Past President of the European Society of Urogenital Radiology (ESUR) and secretary of its contrast media safety committee since 1996.

Professor Morcos is the associate editor of the British Journal of Radiology and Deputy Editor of European Radiology. He is a referee to many scientific journals.

Professor Morcos' is the author of more than 150 scientific publications including several chapters in scientific textbooks. His research interests include thoracic imaging, uro-radiology and the safety of contrast media.

Professor Morcos is the recipient of the Flude Memorial Prize (1993), the Barclay Prize (1997) and the Barclay Medal (2004) of the British Institute of Radiology.
